



The Huntsville Skating Club General Policies

- 1. A Board Member or Coach has the authority to remove any skater from the ice for inappropriate conduct or non-payment of fees.
- 2. For insurance reasons, only Skate Canada members are permitted on the ice surface. Those on the ice need to wear skates and, unless they have successfully passed Skate Canada's CanSkate Level 6, wear a CSA approved helmet. Parents/Guardians are not allowed in the players' benches during skating lessons.
- 3. HSC does not provide any off-ice supervision during non-club related activities.
- 4. Out of club coaches and skater hopping are permitted on HSC's Sunday & Wednesday Fall & Winter sessions and all summer ice sessions. Please refer to Guest Coaching & Hopping Policy.
- 5. When necessary skaters may go to another session for a private lesson with a coach. The skater is to remain on the ice only for the time of the lesson. These lessons are limited to a maximum of 15 minutes per hour. Skaters may skate up or down one session only for these lessons.
- 6. Skater movement between club-determined skater groups, during the year is not permitted unless unanimously approved by all coaches. If the coaches can't agree, then a meeting between coaches, Coach's Liaison and President will be held to work it out.
- 7. HSC bears no responsibility for lost or stolen items.
- 8. When a skater transfers from another club to HSC, they need to provide a printout of their Skate Canada "Detailed Test Record" to the HSC Test Chair.
- 9. The HSC collects a Volunteer Participation Deposit from all club members at a rate set annually by the HSC Board on a per child basis (up to a maximum of 2 deposits per family). By completing two volunteer commitments, per deposit, within the skating season, parents/guardians will be able to have their Volunteer Participation Deposit returned. The deposit amount will be returned, by the treasurer as soon as possible, after the parent/guardian have volunteer commitments approved by a board member.
- Concerns/Complaints will be reviewed only if submitted in writing to the Board email address
 and will be reviewed following the HSC Club Dispute Reporting & Resolution Policy.
